Our Executive Board is recommending that the members approve that plan at a special general membership meeting and lunch on Wednesday, June 25, 2014, at the 100th Infantry Battalion Veterans Education Center clubhouse. Lloyd Kitaoka, president of the 100th Veterans Education Center, has generously allowed us to use the clubhouse for this meeting.

Only members in good standing (i.e., those who have paid their annual dues) will be allowed to vote, although we welcome your attendance at the meeting. You can renew your annual membership with your \$20 fee, so bring your checkbook to our June 25 meeting.

(2) where we want to go, and (3) how we will get there.

Members will also be asked to adopt amendments to our bylaws required to maintain our tax-exempt status as a veterans' organization under Internal Revenue Service regulations.
