# Help Honor the MIS Linguists

Americans of Japanese ancestry who served in the Military Intelligence Service in World War II will be honored with a unit tribute plaque when the National Museum of the United States Army opens next summer near Washington, D.C.

The MIS Veterans Hawaii has kicked off a campaign to raise \$5,000 for the plaque, which will recognize all MIS nisei linguists who served in the war and the occupation of Japan. You can help by making your donation at <https://armyhistory.causevox.com/mis-veterans-hawaii>

Unit plaques, each measuring 12 by 18 inches, will be displayed along the Path of Remembrance at the museum at Fort Belvoir, Virginia. The Army Historical Foundation is raising \$200 million to finance the museum, which will be the first with a comprehensive view of the entire Army and its history.

AJAs will be featured in several of the museum's exhibits, not only those who served in the MIS but also the 100th Infantry Battalion and 442nd Regimental Combat Team.
