MIS Bonenkai Cancelled

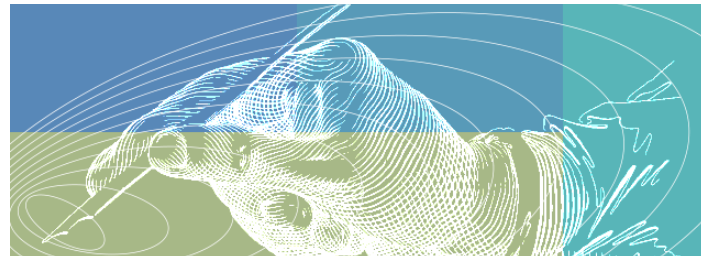

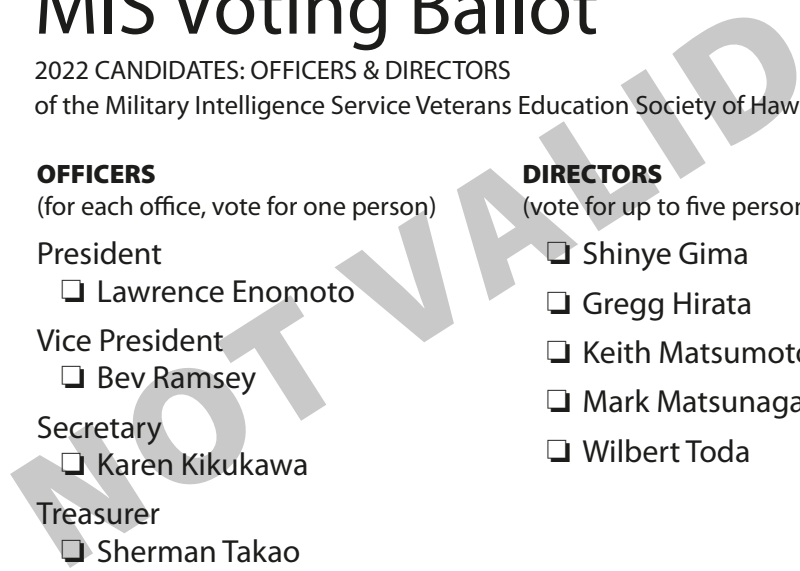
